

Persecution of Muslims

Muslims in Burma are probably the most oppressed group in the country.

They are denied citizenship and the freedom to study or travel.

Tens of thousands of Muslim Rohingyas have fled to Bangladesh to escape systemic rape and forced labour.

In Karen State the Burmese Army and militias has burned or forcibly relocated Muslim villages, destroyed mosques, used Muslim cemeteries as pig farms, and kidnapped and raped Muslim girls and women.
